Nebraska Disaster Behavioral Health: Psychological First Aid Curriculum

This training program is an adaptation of "Community-Based Psychological Support" developed by the International Federation of Red Cross and Red Crescent Societies. The purpose of the Nebraska psychological first aid program is to equip natural helpers to provide psychological support to survivors of critical events (e.g., disasters, conflicts, accidents, etc.).
